

## Nursery Procedures



The following procedures will make it simple and easy to use the nursery:

1. Let your child know that the nursery is a safe place to play and be with friends. Tell him/her you will be back to get him/her in a short time.
2. It's hard to say goodbye. Our experience has been that it is easier on all parties to make it short and sweet.
3. Equip your child for a comfortable stay by bringing two extra diapers, bottles or food, pacifier (if your child uses one), and a complete change of clothes. Any special needs should be written down and pinned to the child's bag. Clearly label your child's belongings.
4. For precautionary measures we ask that you please only bring well children to the nursery. Sick children endanger the health of other children and adults. Please do not bring your child to the nursery if he or she has any of the following or symptoms: fever, vomiting or diarrhea, coughing, sneezing, or runny eyes, or sore throat.

The nursery workers who care for the children are all volunteer members of the St. James church family. We ask that parents who are members of St. James placing a child in the nursery please volunteer to work in the nursery on a rotational basis.
